Old and New Subsystems of Color Vision. Our own trichromatic color vision depends on two subsystems, a phylogenetically recent one overlaid on a much more ancient one. Most mammals are dichromatic, having only two types of cone receptor in the retina. For the main business of vision—the detection of movement and form—they rely on a single class of cone, with its peak sensitivity at long wavelengths (500 – 570 nm).

People with colour vision deficiency are unable to see colours clearly and accurately. They may find it difficult to distinguish between different colours. Colour vision deficiency is often called ‘ colour blindness ’. However, actual colour blindness, where no colour seen at all, is rare. People with colour vision deficiency may have difficulty identifying pale colours or deep colours if the lighting is poor.

The process of color vision starts in the retina according to the Trichromatic Theory. This theory was developed by Thomas Young and Herman von Helmholtz, and thus it is also called the Young-Helmholtz theory. In the trichromatic theory, they proposed that the retina is comprised of three distinct types of cones or color-sensitive photoreceptors.

Color vision uses two properties of light to create visual contrasts. One property is effective energy, that is, the number of quanta in the light. The other is the frequency of vibration, or wavelength, of the absorbed quanta.
