The GRE Psychology Test shows to correlate better with first-year graduate school GPAs than does the GRE General Test ($r = .33$); the GRE Psychology Test correlates equivocally with undergraduate GPA correlations (both equal $r = .37$). However, it is also stated that a GRE subject test correlates with degree attainment only $r = .21$. While it has strong correlations with some facets of graduate school, overall it does not predict who will graduate and who will not.
