In conclusion, about 30% of the global burden of disease could be surgical. This estimation is robust to multiple estimation methods and avoids limiting the delineation of "surgical disease" only to patients who end up on an operating table. Although non-surgeons estimate a lower burden of surgical disease than do surgeons, all providers estimate a burden that is more than double the canonical 11% estimation published in 2006.

When this has been demonstrated, surgery may be useful along with the usual medical measures. The operative procedure (sympathectomy) involves disrupting the automatic nerve supply to the vessels which holds them in spasm. The GHE disease category with the highest rate of operative frequency was sense organ diseases (86.6%), followed by genitourinary diseases (74.0%) and musculoskeletal diseases (58.0%). These three categories also had the highest total number of surgical procedures; genitourinary diseases with 263 637 procedures, musculoskeletal diseases with 237 281 procedures and sense organ diseases with 235 561 procedures.

Probably the most serious thing that can happen during surgery in those with liver disease is decreased flow of oxygenated blood to the liver.
